

Meeting Summary

10am, 14 January 2010

Wealden DC, Hailsham

The ESSP met on 14 January 2010 for its quarterly meeting to discuss progress on key activities. The partnership received a presentation on the **East Sussex Compact**, the achievements in 2009/10, the way forward and what support is requested from the ESSP.

Progress on the **Local Area Agreement** was scrutinised through the Year 2, Quarter 2 Performance Monitoring Report which included additional disaggregated data. Members also discussed the **annual LAA refresh** process which will focus on NI 153, 154 and 155.

The partnership received updates from each of the five theme **champions** on their priority issue from the Countywide Action Plan which highlighted excellent examples of partnership-working across the county including commitments to data-sharing between the police and NHS and the joint approach to developing Local Transport Plan 3.

Finally, members discussed a number of changes locally and nationally which will undoubtedly affect the ESSP, and what **the future** may mean for the partnership. It was decided that no governance decisions would be made at this point, and that the issue of how to respond to these challenges will be looked at in the summer/autumn of 2010.
