

## **ESSP Executive Board Meetings Friday 17 July 2009**

### **Meeting Summary:**

The ESSP Executive Board met on the 17 July for their quarterly meeting to discuss progress on key activities. Board members received a presentation from the Audit Commission on the **emerging picture** for the Comprehensive Area Assessment (CAA). Board members discussed the recent ESSP **governance consultation** and agreed to support some of the recommendations made within the report presented but also to invest in more consultation with District and Borough Local Strategic Partnerships, Countywide Thematic Partnerships and Speak in order to ensure ESSP is fit for purpose.

Board members also received and approved recommendations for **updating** three Pride of Place themes: community safety, older people and children and young people. In addition, the Board approved which five areas of the Pride of Place Countywide Action Plan to target first and a relevant Board member to “champion” each area.

ESSP’s Migrant Research Project Group was congratulated on their recent **funding success**, having secured £340,000 for their work supporting migrant communities across East Sussex. The Board received the Quarter 4 **performance monitoring** reports for the both LAA 1 and LAA 2, with shows over 60% of LAA1 targets being achieved and LAA2 continuing to perform well.

Finally, Jeremy Leggett was **re-elected** as Chair of the ESSP for another two year term.
