

## Wealden

### **Issues , Opportunities & Actions:**

- Whether LSPs in general have slipped away from focus on delivering community priorities and are now used by some partners to pursue their own agendas;
- For Wealden whether our focus on LDF has diverted attention from other key matters - and the fact that once the LDF is 'signed off' we will have to return to these other issues - which may have been allowed to slide in the interim;
- Are we sufficiently aware of/prioritising those areas in the LAA where funding is available to reward performance? And will any filter down from County to Districts and Boroughs;
- Should LSP Chairs and LA Chief Executives meet on a regular basis - annually?
- In current economic climate need to focus on a few key priorities and deliver community aspirations - demonstrate success/validate existence;
- Need to consider when to go up a level and try and influence strategies - transport?
- How does the SCS (and ISCS) influence/govern the existing partnerships? Are they sufficiently aware of the issues discussed at LSP Board? How can we improve the flow of information between partnerships; and between partnerships and the LSP;
- Should LSP Board meetings have standing item for updates from each partnership?
- We have gaps - transport/education etc - not necessarily an issue providing there is coverage at a county level and providing the LSP has a voice. Are we comfortable that this is the case?
