Factors impacting on social networks

- Third of households in 2021 single person
- Family, community and neighbourhood may weaken or change
- Friendships based on work rather than neighbourhood
- Culture of individualism and social isolation
- Ghetto-isation may be increasing
- Continued rise of litigation culture weakens sense of personal responsibility



Challenges for engagement

- Not static or fixed but transitory: networks
- Based around a sense of belonging : more than being consulted or being called citizens
- Access to information and opinion from diverse sources shapes values, expectations and behaviour that challenges professional control: virtual communities
- Public services place greater emphasis on innovation and collaboration between users and providers
